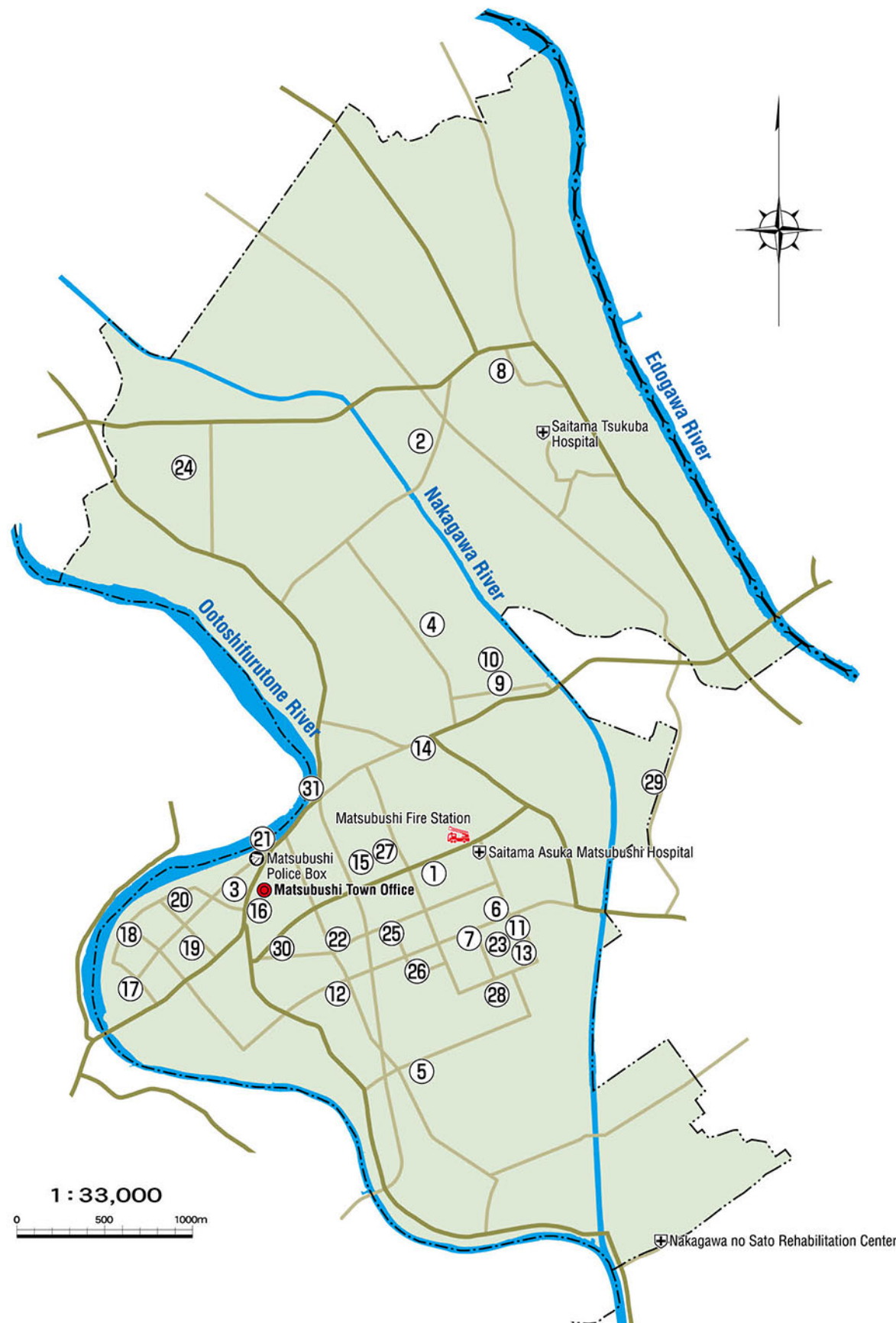


# Evacuation site in Matsubushi Town

Listed here are designated evacuation shelters and designated emergency evacuation sites in Matsubushi Town. Make sure you know where to evacuate to in the vicinity of your home so that you can evacuate smoothly and carry out rescue and relief activities in the event of a disaster.

## List of Designated Evacuation Shelters and Designated Emergency Evacuation Sites

### What is a designated evacuation shelter?

It is a facility where people who are unable to return home because their home is in danger or who evacuate until the danger disappears temporarily. Matsubushi Town has 16 designated evacuation shelters, including schools and public facilities.

Not all designated evacuation shelters will be opened in the event of a disaster. For information on opening, please check the disaster prevention administrative radio, Matsubushi Town official website, Map-Mail, NHK and TV Saitama data broadcasting (d button), etc.

### What is a designated emergency evacuation site?

A temporary evacuation area to escape from danger when a disaster occurs or is likely to occur. In addition to the designated evacuation shelters, there are different places to evacuate to depending on the disaster, such as parks, facilities on high grounds and the roofs of buildings. Check the designated emergency evacuation sites, such as your home or school, for each disaster.

\*Welfare shelter...Evacuation centers for people who need special consideration (persons requiring special care), such as the elderly, people with disabilities (children with disabilities), expectant and nursing mothers, infants, and the sick.
